**Nationalism and Human Rights - Coding Rules for Turkey Case (1999-2016) - Chief Executive** = The chief executive who served at least 6 months in a given year between 1999-2016.  
Nationalism Score:

- Key words/phrases: positive mentions of nationalism, national interests/benefits, national security, national unity, national culture, national solidarity, national history, national priorities, national ideals, and external ethnic kin.
- After searching for keywords, I hand-coded each sentence to decide whether they are positive mentions of nationalism. I calculated the percentage of the number of the words in the sentences favoring nationalism in the total number of words in the speech.
- If there is any negative mention of nationalism (anti-nationalist narrative), it is subtracted from the number of words of positive mentions to get a more accurate value representing nationalism score of the chief executive/government.
- If there are more than one speech in a given year, I used the mean of the scores for these speeches.
- If there is no speech in a given year according to the criteria above, the last available speech is used to determine the nationalism score of the chief executive in a given year.
- I specifically used presentation of government program at the national assembly by the chief executives. Even if a government consists multiple parties (coalition governments), these speeches reflect the entire government's ideology. Also, these speeches are perfectly comparable given their similar audience, length, and content. I used the official archives of the Grand National Assembly of Turkey (<https://www.tbmm.gov.tr/tutanak/tutanaklar.htm>) to find the original speeches. I excluded the speeches if they are exclusively technical (budget talks) which would have very few mentions of nationalism (if any) or speeches on national holidays which are inherently nationalist independently from government party's ideology. In total, I coded 8 speeches.
