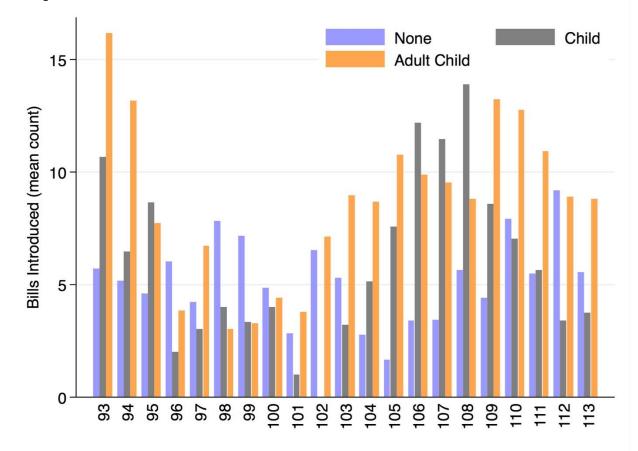


Figure B1: Mean Number of Child and Family Bills Introduced by Session by Parental Group
