24-hour dietary recall	Household survey	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- What people eat and where it is purchased in relation to food shopping practices and preferences- What people eat and where it is purchased in relation to food risk perception and trust (vegetables only)
Price data (vegetables)	Census Household survey 24-hour dietary recall	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Where and what people buy related to food retail availability AND prices- Where and what people buy related to risk perception, trust AND prices
