Spousal relative income and male psychological distress

METHODOLOGY FILE

Data

This study uses US data from the Panel Study of Income Dynamics (PSID), which is a longitudinal household survey collecting a wide range of individual and household demographic, income, labour market, and health variables biennially. Given the topic of this research, the final sample consists exclusively of married heterosexual individuals, 6,288 couples with a total number of observations equal to 20,398 over 2001-2015 biennial waves.

Variable definitions

"K-6 NON-SPEC PSYCHOL DISTRESS SCALE"

The K-6 Non-Specific Psychological Distress Scale

This scale was developed by Dr Ronald Kessler, Professor of Healthcare Policy at Harvard Medical School. It includes six items, using a scale of 1-5, which ranges from 'all of the time' to 'none of the time.' The items are rescored as follows: A response of 'All of the Time' = 4 points, 'Most of the Time' = 3 points, 'Some of the Time' = 2 points, 'A Little of the Time' = 1 point, and 'None of the Time' = 0 points. The scores are summed.
