Supplementary Figure 1. Exemplary autoclave load in the case of a calf carcass.


Two stainless steel boxes with the torso in the bottom box and head and limbs in the upper box inside the autoclave chamber.




Supplementary Figure 2. Temperature graphs at the tissue level during validation run 2 and 3 of pig carcasses.
